The third meeting "Europe, the place where we like to live" will be held in Municipality of Nughedu Santa Vittoria, Italy, during 31/08/2016-02/09/2016. This event addresses vulnerable groups- people discriminated by their background, gender and any disabilities. Different countries have different approach to deal with their problems. An international conference "Local authorities and their role in providing equal opportunities for the citizens of EU" aim exchange experience and good practices to prevent xenophobia, racism, discrimination and tolerance enhancement; spread an inquiry "What are your expectation for the future of EU"; a round table "Social policy in EU, what can be changed?" aim exchange experience and good practices to provide municipal social services; a round table "Equal opportunities". Minimum 76 participant, representatives of local authorities, citizens of vulnerable groups; disadvantaged people.

The forth meeting "Europe, we want to be" will be held in Pomorie, Bulgaria, during 29/03/2017-31/03/2017. This event will be public discussion about EU future and Network of Towns. The result of it will be a document, containing future initiatives of twinned municipalities and areas of cooperation, conditions of joining the partner network. During this event the participants could estimate the contest works: "The Europe, we want to be!". In the frame of event will be held a round table "Program of the Network of Towns", to discuss future initiatives of twinned municipalities and areas of cooperation, conditions for joining the partner net-

work; summarizing the results of the accomplish survey and round tables. Minimum 25 participants, decision makers and policy-makers on the local level, citizens.
